**Athletic Director Report:**

This would involve someone from our community doing some research to put the book contents together. Brillion has done this as a fundraiser; book cost was \$40.

**Presidents Report:**

**Ideas on filling Treasurer/Secretary position:** A post will be made on Facebook that we really need someone to take over as treasurer of CBC. We are in great need of more parent involvement in CBC. Each board member should invite two families to February meeting. Consider handouts at games. We need to reach out to middle school families.

Further, a new credit card would have to be obtained with every new concession manager. It was agreed that every effort would be made to provide prompt reimbursement to concession expenses incurred. It was agreed that a check could be given to Wendy Schwarz for large purchases at times of the year when the largest concession purchases are made.
