

CHILTON BOOSTER CLUB

August 12, 2020

Minutes

The August meeting of the Chilton Booster Club was held via Zoom due to the COVID-19 pandemic. President Joe Halbach called the meeting to order at 6:03 p.m. In attendance were Stephanie Bartels, Corey Behnke, Jill Frank, Joe & Maria Halbach, Jessica Heimann, Deb Leitner, Michelle Moehn, Leona Propson and Pam Woelfel.

Audience Participation: Football Coach Michael Arendt

Minutes of June Meeting: Jessica H. made a motion to accept the June meeting minutes and Leona P. seconded it. M/C

Treasurer's Report: Shane G. was unable to be present for the meeting, but he did provide financial reports to Joe H. July expenses included: \$1,718 to Jim McClowry/Credible Coach, \$200 for JV baseball hitting camp and \$600 for summer baseball umpires. Shane still working on reviewing financials and balancing accounts. Pam W. made a motion to accept the treasurer's report and Deb L. seconded it. M/C

Athletic Director Report:

Athletic Director Corey Behnke discussed the first class for the athletic coaches held in July with Jim McClowry of The Credible Coach. Corey B. believed McClowry is providing them valuable knowledge regarding how to best work with student athletes. They are currently working on a mission statement for each sport as well as a mission statement for Chilton athletics as a whole. The coaches provided positive feedback to Corey B., and they believed the training at the first class was very beneficial to their professional development. There will be seven classes held throughout the year.

Fall Wish List Items:

- (1) 48 flags are needed for cross country. The school would pay for 24, and they are requesting that CBC pay for the remaining 24. The cost to CBC would be \$960.
- (2) Replace the 4 iPads currently being used for Chilton High School athletics. Corey B. believes many athletic events will be live-streamed so spectators can watch, and our current iPads are older, and they have slower cameras which may cause issues while streaming live events. The school would pay for two iPads, and they are requesting that CBC pay for the other two at a cost of \$575 each (total of \$1,150).
- (3) Football Coach Michael Arendt was present to discuss the GoRout program which was purchased for football last year. Coach Arendt gave positive feedback on the program. When it was approved, it was agreed that the Tiger Touchdown Club would pay the annual fee for the program, which was \$995 per year. With the pandemic, the club has been unable to do any fundraising; therefore, they are unable to pay the \$995 fee.

Coach Arendt stated if they are unable to have football this fall, the annual fee would be credited toward next year's fee. If there is a partial season, the fee will be prorated.

Corey B. reported that there is a WIAA meeting on Friday, August 14, 2020, so he may have more information about fall sports at that time.

President's Report:

Unfinished Business:

Website. Michelle M. contacted Kelly Moehn to see if she knew of anyone who could assist us in creating a new website. Kelly M. stated she did not, and she had also talked to Brian Bartel, and he was not aware of anyone either. Kelly M. indicated there are sites which are very user friendly to create your own website. Corey B. stated he would talk to technology staff at school to see if they know of anybody who could assist us. Corey B. also stated Google has a free program to set up websites. It was discussed that we may want to consider paying someone to create and maintain our website to get a high quality product rather than create a website that is not very user friendly.

Fundraising Update:

All fundraisers/concessions are on hold until further notice due to the COVID-19 pandemic. A discussion was held regarding the annual volleyball tournament. At this point, things are on hold. Most volleyball tournaments have been canceled for the fall.

Clothing: Pam W. reported the football clothing is in, and they are considering reopening the order at some point. The volleyball clothing should be ready in about two weeks, and they are currently taking orders for cross country. Pam asked about the Homecoming clothing order that CBC normally does for all grade levels. A decision will be made once we learn how Homecoming will proceed. Homecoming may still happen but will obviously be different than previous years.

New Business:

Joe H. asked each CBC director to invite one person to the September meeting. We need to bring in additional people to be involved with CBC.

Pam W. made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 6:36 p.m., and Jessica H. seconded it. M/C
