Minutes

President Joe Halbach called the meeting to order at 6:02 p.m. In attendance were Joe Halbach, Michelle Moehn, Athletic Director Corey Behnke, Stephanie Bartels, Shane Glidden, Chris Marx, Janet Murphy, Leona Propson, Cindy Rowland, Wendy Schwarz and Pam Woelfel.

Audience Participation: Teacher/Coach Mike Arendt & Lupita Shymanski

Minutes of November Meeting: Pam W. made a motion to accept the November meeting minutes and Wendy S. seconded it. M/C

Treasurer's Report: Ben H. gave a report via online video chat. Recent expenses included: \$500 Danny Mallmann (b-ball fund); \$231.55 Valley Popcorn; \$415.50 Eagle Graphics (volleyball account); 120.00 Hilbert Boosters for chalk entry (sport support); \$58.75 & \$298.77 Leah Cisler (vball account); \$90 Valders Volleyball (vball account); and \$120 for a basketball tournament. Deposit: \$349.18. Shane G. made a motion to accept the treasurer's report and Leona P. seconded it. M/C

Athletic Director Report:

Mike Arendt was present to provide more information regarding the winter wishlist item requested: TrainHeroic, an app-based weight training platform. Due to the extended football season, Mr. Arendt wasn't able to run the trial period. He will be starting the free trial period the following week. Mr. Arendt made contact with representatives from schools in Edgar and Sun Prairie, and both loved the program. When using the program, the programs can be modified for each athlete: they can create their own workouts or there would be pre-programmed workouts to choose from. There could be different programs for in-season and out-of-season. The app is free to download, and it can be used by members of the community. The price is \$1,350 annually or \$112.50 monthly. This is a reduced rate which is offered for high schools.

After Corey and Mike Arendt left, a discussion was held to decide if CBC would fund the program. It was addressed that before the program is renewed after the first year, we would need data regarding how many athletes were actively using the program. It was decided that the annual fee would work better because a credit card is needed for monthly payments. After discussion, Janet M. made a motion to approve purchasing the TrainHeroic program, and Cindy R. seconded it. M/C.

Presidents Report:

WE ARE STILL IN NEED OF SOMEONE TO FILL THE ROLE OF VICE PRESIDENT

Discussion was held regarding why the term of the president was only for one year and how it was originally decided to have it that way. After the meeting, Michelle M. contacted Mary Jo Weber to obtain additional information. Mary Jo W. advised that it was set up so that an individual would have a three year commitment: one year as Vice President, one year as President, and one year as Past President. According to Mary Jo, the intent was that the Past President would attend the monthly meetings during the third year but would be a non-voting member. They would be there to provide input to assist the current President.

Basketball Tournaments:

Boys: Not enough teams signed up for the middle school boys basketball tournament on December 14, 2019, so the decision was made to cancel it. Shane G. planned to contact coaches who had previously signed up for the tournament to determine why they did not sign up, since this tournament has been run the same weekend for many years.

After the meeting, Shane did receive some feedback indicating that many teams are now participating in weekend leagues rather than tournaments. Mary Jo Anhalt sent an email suggesting that we should consider a 3-on-3 tournament at a later date. Further discussion will be held at the January meeting.

Girls: Per Leona P., 7th grade is full with eight teams. They currently have four 8th grade teams.

Unfinished Business:

Michelle M. spoke with Teacher Kelly Moehn about the Homecoming Spirit Wear Order. Mrs. Moehn has no issue with CBC continuing to run that order, but mentioned that she would gladly take it over if CBC decided they don't want to continue running the sale.

New Business:

Concessions were discussed, and it was discussed that better directions are needed for the concession stands. Groups providing workers for the concession are not aware of the need to restock the cooler.
