### Minutes

President Joe Halbach called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. In attendance were Joe Halbach, Ben Hertel, Michelle Moehn, Athletic Director Corey Behnke, Mary Jo Anhalt, Maria Halbach, Jill Frank, Deb Leitner, Chris Marx, Leona Propson, Cindy Rowland, Wendy Schwarz and Ann Wilcox.

**Audience Participation:** Chilton Public Schools Superintendent Sue Kaphingst and Lupita Shymanski.

**Minutes of July Meeting:** Mary Jo. A. made a motion to accept the July meeting minutes and Ann W. seconded it. M/C

**Treasurer's Report:** Ben H. provided a verbal treasurer's report. \$250 was paid to Lawrence University for volleyball tournament. No other activity.

**Athletic Director Report:**

Jody Schwarz was hired as the new head coach for girls swimming.

Superintendent Sue Kaphingst was present to discuss issues at Morrissey Park. The Co-Curricular Committee is looking for community members to help come up with solutions for the issues at Morrissey Park. There will be no more home track meets due to safety concerns.

There are currently several issues with the facilities at Morrissey Park:

- (1) Travel to and from. Students have been involved in accidents going to and from Morrissey Park for practices. Also, there are times when the students are unsupervised.
- (2) Inclement weather. There is not appropriate shelter in cases of inclement weather.
- (3) Conditions of surfaces. Rain run-off from the hill is causing pitting on the track surface, and there is a lot of dirt and debris that washes onto the track surface after it rains. Painted areas on the track are very slippery when wet.
- (4) Open access to public. Several dangerous items have been located on the track, on the football field and in the sand areas. Items located included, but were not limited to: switchblades (one was buried in long jump sand), condoms, beer cans and broken glass. There has been graffiti on the wall and the storage shed, and equipment has been damaged (including broken hurdles and a puncture in the pit mat).

**Presidents Report:**

**Volleyball Tournament:** The middle school (grades 5-8) volleyball tournament is scheduled for Sunday, September 15, 2019. Set-up will be on Saturday. Games will only be held at the high school, not at middle school. They are currently looking for more teams. They will be capping it at 16 teams. Help will be needed for concessions.

7<sup>th</sup> Grade Volleyball Sport Support: A request was submitted requesting additional sport support for 7<sup>th</sup> grade volleyball as they have a very large team. After further discussion, it was decided that CBC was not able to provide additional financial support, as \$400 is allotted per sport per grade level. There are currently funds in the volleyball account (youth volleyball activity account). Varsity Head Coach Leah Cisler indicated \$200 of that account could be used for additional fees incurred for 7<sup>th</sup> grade volleyball tournaments.

Middle School Basketball Tournament: The tournament for boys basketball has been scheduled for Saturday, December 14, 2019.

Girls Middle School Basketball Tournament: The tournament for girls basketball has been scheduled for Saturday, January 25, 2020. Joe H. will contact Bob Broeckel to schedule referees.

**Football/Concessions Update:**

Joe H. will be looking into obtaining a debit card for the concession directors to purchase supplies.

Help will be needed for concessions for football games.

A discussion was held regarding trying to find a simplified way to pay groups for concession stand coverage. Currently, because CBC provides all of the product for concession stands, an inventory must be taken before the game (meaning every candy bar, every drink, etc., must be counted). An inventory would then have to be taken after the game, and the treasurer would have to determine what profit was made on each item. It was decided it would be a much simpler process if the group can be paid a percentage of the concession sales. Ben H. to look at the amounts paid to groups in previous years. Further discussion will be held to decide what the appropriate percentage shall be.
