Minutes of April Meeting: Tim M. made a motion to accept the April meeting minutes and Pam W. seconded it. M/C

Presidents Report:

Scholarship Update: Scholarships will be presented at the senior awards night on May 8, 2019.

Bylaw Changes: By-Laws with recommended changes will be reviewed at June meeting.

Athletic Director Report:

We are still in need of coaches for Volleyball JV1 and JV2.

Treasurer's Report: Mary Jo W. provided an unofficial treasurer's report. April DQ raised \$125.75. Eagle Graphics clothing profits for second track order was \$37.98. Received bill from Printing Express in the amount of \$66.25 for printing flyers to hand out to parents.

We will have a table at Chilton Middle School Fine Arts Night on May 14, 2019, from 4-7 p.m. Mary Jo A. and Corey B. will be there. Lupita Shymanski agreed to assist that night.

Fundraising Update:

DQ Night: Next DQ night is Tuesday, June 4, 2019, from 5-8 p.m. Janet M. has agreed to be the person to put the DQ night signs near the school on scheduled DQ nights.

Concessions – Final Update:

Track concessions went well. Spaghetios went over well.

The concession stand by Morrissey Park was broken into on Sunday, May 5, 2019, but the kids involved were caught. It was determined approximately \$30 worth of property was stolen. The kids were required to pay for the items they stole.

Youth football has asked CBC to take over the concession stand for them.

Other Items of Business:

Chris Marx and Shane Glidden of Chilton Athletic Club were present to ask CBC to fund a summer baseball league for incoming freshmen, sophomores and juniors. The league would run on Tuesdays and Thursdays between June 6, 2019, and July 18, 2019. There will be five home games and five away games. They were looking for funds to help purchase uniform tops and baseballs and to pay umpires. They were advised that CBC provides \$400 per school year for each level, \$400 for JV and \$400 for Varsity, so there was already \$800 available for baseball sport support. \$250 had already been allocated to have a pitching coach come in and do an activity with the pitchers. This left a balance of \$550. Umpire cost would be \$120 per night (\$60 per game) for the five home games. Mary Jo W. made a motion to approve the funding of the baseball summer league and Janet M. seconded it. M/C.
